<p><b>Special Offerings:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One Great Hour of Sharing – disaster response, refugee assistance and community development to help people find safe refuge, start new lives and work together to strengthen their families and communities.</li> <li>• Christmas Joy – supports retired and active church workers, their spouses and families as well as racial ethnic education.</li> <li>• Peacemaking – supports the PC (USA) Peacemaking Program’s ministry. Congregations are encouraged to keep 25% of the offering for local ministries of peacemaking within the church and its community. 25% is used by presbyteries and synods and 50% is for the Presbyterian peacemaking program.</li> <li>• Pentecost – assists children at risk, youth and young adults. Congregations are encouraged to keep 40% of the offering to support ministry with children at risk in their communities. The 60% (sent through the remittance center) for GA provides leadership development opportunities for Presbyterian youth and young adults and supports children at risk programs.</li> </ul> <p><b>Special Gifts:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Presbyterian Disaster Assistance enables compassionate response to emergency needs.</li> <li>• Presbyterian Hunger Fund supports the Presbyterian Hunger Program</li> <li>• Theological Education Fund – (1% plan) provides the only denominational support for Presbyterian seminaries and is the congregation’s proportionate share for the education of present and future ministers.</li> </ul> <hr style="width: 20%; margin-left: 0;"/> <p><b>Extra commitment opportunities (ECO)</b> support mission not funded by adopted budgets.
