<p>Special Offerings:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One Great Hour of Sharing – disaster response, refugee assistance and community development to help people find safe refuge, start new lives and work together to strengthen their families and communities. • Christmas Joy – supports retired and active church workers, their spouses and families as well as racial ethnic education. • Peace and Global Witness Offering - enables the church to promote the Peace of Christ by addressing systems of injustice across the world. Congregations are encouraged to keep 25% of the offering for local ministries of peacemaking within the church and its community. 25% is used by Mid-councils and 50% is for the Presbyterian peacemaking program. • Pentecost – assists children at risk, youth and young adults. Congregations are encouraged to keep 40% of the offering to support ministry with children at risk in their communities.
